Insha Allah.

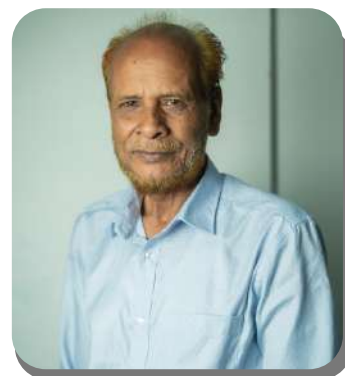

ADMISSION & ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES

ADMISSION

1. Admission forms will be available from the first week of November every year.
2. The Admission Form fee is ₹200/-.
3. The following documents (photocopies) must be submitted along with the admission form:

- a) Birth Certificate and Aadhaar Card
- b) Transfer Certificate from the last school attended, with PEN (for KG-I to Class VII)
- c) Recent passport-size photographs of the student (3 copies)
- d) Recent passport-size photographs of parents/guardians (2 copies), along with their Aadhaar Cards
- e) Caste Certificate (SC / ST / OBC / MOBC) – to be produced at the time of admission
- f) Blood Group Certificate
- g) In case of a legal guardian, an authentic certificate along with an undertaking must be provided

Note: Original documents must be produced at the time of admission for verification.

ATTENDANCE

1. As per CBSE norms, a minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory eligibility to appear in the Annual Examination.
2. Prior intimation is required for all leave requests. Strict action will be taken against students who remain absent for more than three consecutive days without informing the school.
3. For medical leave, a medical certificate must be submitted.
4. Absence from school during social functions should be avoided.
5. Students suffering from infectious diseases must produce a medical fitness certificate from a competent authority before resuming classes.

Duration of Leave for Common Illnesses:

- Cholera: Until complete recovery
- Mumps: Until swelling subsides
- Viral Fever: One week
- Typhoid: Twenty-one days
- Conjunctivitis: Until complete recovery

6. Absence without prior information will be considered unauthorized and treated as absent.

For Parents / Guardians

1. Parents or guardians may meet teachers only after school hours or with prior permission.
2. The academic session will be from April to March.
3. Tuition fees must be paid on or before the 10th of every month. A fine of ₹20 per day will be charged for late payment.
4. Parents/Guardians are expected to keep regular contact with the school regarding their child's progress.
5. Attendance at Parent-Teacher Meetings is mandatory for guardians/parents.
6. Presence of both student and guardian is compulsory on the day of result declaration.

Students

1. Students must maintain discipline, respect, and decorum within the school premises.
2. Reasons for absence must be recorded in the Absence Record in the school diary and supported by a leave application.
3. Admission and promotion depend strictly on academic performance and regular attendance.
4. Transfer requests must be submitted one month in advance in writing.

Parents are requested to send only healthy home-made vegetarian food (such as rice, pulao, chapati, paratha, oats, brown or multigrain bread); junk food, packaged food, and non-vegetarian items (meat, fish, etc.) are strictly prohibited.

Additional Guidelines

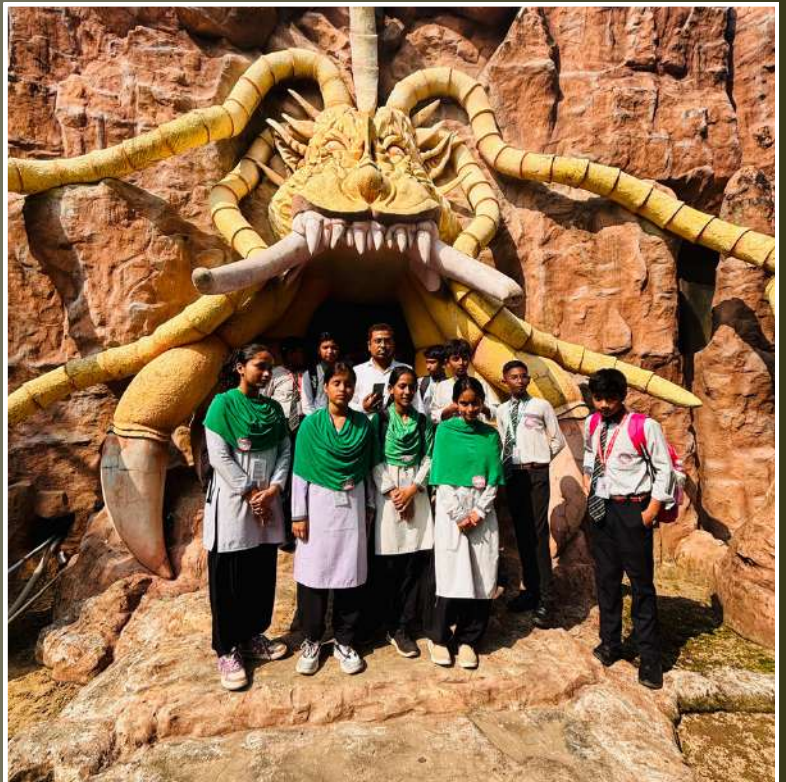
